Inspite of millions of dollars in Funding and International backing (even Silicon Valley!), several Indian Startups Fail

























Prepare, Practice and Present your new startup idea to an expert panel and get valuable feedback

He started his first venture at the age of 16. Since then he is passionately working towards the development of the startup ecosystem by helping fellow entrepreneurs and creating an impact by his talks.


